



REAR WHEEL BAG

Thank you for purchasing a Tuff Terrain Rear Wheel Bag. Tuff Terrain aims to provide a quality product to enhance your exploration of the outdoors. Please read the following fitment guide before fitting your Tuff Terrain Rear Wheel Bag.

WARNING

Improper installation or use of your Rear Wheel Bag may result in serious injury or death. You will need to follow these installation instructions to ensure proper installation on your vehicle and continued safe use of your Rear Wheel Bag. Not all wheels and tyres will accommodate fitment of this rear wheel bag.

SAFETY WARNING

KEEP ALL FLAME AND HEAT SOURCES AWAY FROM THE BAG MATERIALS

To fit a 29-31" tyre:

- **1.** Hold the bag up to the spare wheel.
- 2. Take each strap and place over and behind the opposite side (criss-cross).



3. Pull the straps down behind the tyre and then click the male buckle on the end of each strap into the female buckles, located on the bottom of the Rear Wheel Bag.



4. Firmly pull any excess strap to ensure that the straps are taut.

To fit a 33-35" tyre:

- 1. Hold the bag up to the spare wheel
- 2. Take each strap and place over and behind the tyre.



3. Feed the straps through from the rear of the wheel/rim to the front.



4. Click the male buckle on the end of each strap into the female buckles, located on the bottom of the Rear Wheel Bag.



5. Firmly Pull any excess strap to ensure that the straps are taut.

Helpful Tips -

- 1. To ensure that the straps do not come loose from corrugations and rough road, it is recommended that you roll up the excess strap (after tightening) and use a zip tie to secure the excess strap neatly at the closest point to the male buckle. This will prevent the straps from loosening and prevent the excess strap from being caught on anything etc.
- 2. If fitting the straps through the wheel, check the edges of the spokes/cutouts to ensure that they are not sharp and will not cut through the strap. It is recommended to remove any sharp edges if found, before fitting the bag.

CLEANING AND STORAGE

Do not clean the Rear Wheel bag with any petroleum or spirit-based products. For general cleaning, it is recommended to occasionally use a garden hose to wet the material of the bag and scrub the bag with a wash mitt until clean. Rinse and allow to dry.

To clean the inside of the bag, simply use a wet cloth to wipe the interior surface until clean and allow to dry.

When storing the bag, ensure that it is clean and dry to avoid rot and mould damage to the material.

12 MONTH WARRANTY

12 month limited warranty applies to the original purchaser under the following conditions. This warranty will warrant against manufacturing faults and defects for the period of 12 months from purchase date. This warranty does not include damage caused from misuse, mould, weather, accidents, wear and tear or incorrect installation.

This warranty applies in addition to guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. To make a claim, please ensure to retain your sales receipt of purchase.
